

# **CPSC Beginner & Low Intermediate Match Play Orientation**

## Welcome to Beginner & Low Intermediate Match Play at Centennial Parklands Sports Centre

This program is designed for players who want to ease into playing matches! Coach-guided and held in a social environment with a box-doubles format (play with a new partner and a new opponent each round), put your skills into practice with players of a similar standard.

#### Where are the Centennial Parklands Sports Centre tennis courts?

Our 11 tennis courts (9 synthetic grass, 2 hardcourt) are located across the road from The Entertainment Quarter. Programs are usually held on Courts 1 to 4.

#### What to bring...

Your tennis racquet and a water bottle. Wear comfortable athletic gear and tennis shoes. Racquets are also available for loan from our Tennis Kiosk for a fee.

#### What you can expect...

The session will commence with a short five-minute warm-up period. After that, the coach will start matches. Additionally:

- Rotations are ~15 minutes long.
- If the score is tied at the end of a rotation, all four players must move to the baseline. From there, one player drop-feeds the ball with a fair feed and a sudden death point to determine who moves up and down is played out.
- Winners move toward the "top court" and losers toward the "bottom court". When players get to their new court, they must split up so that they are in a new partnership.
- The short deuce scoring format will be used; if the game gets to deuce, the receiving team elects which side the server will serve to and a sudden death point is played out.
- Players may drop-feed their 2nd serves if they choose. The drop-feed must land in the appropriate service box.



### What if it's raining?

You will receive an SMS from the CPSC team if your lesson has been cancelled at least an hour before its scheduled start time.
